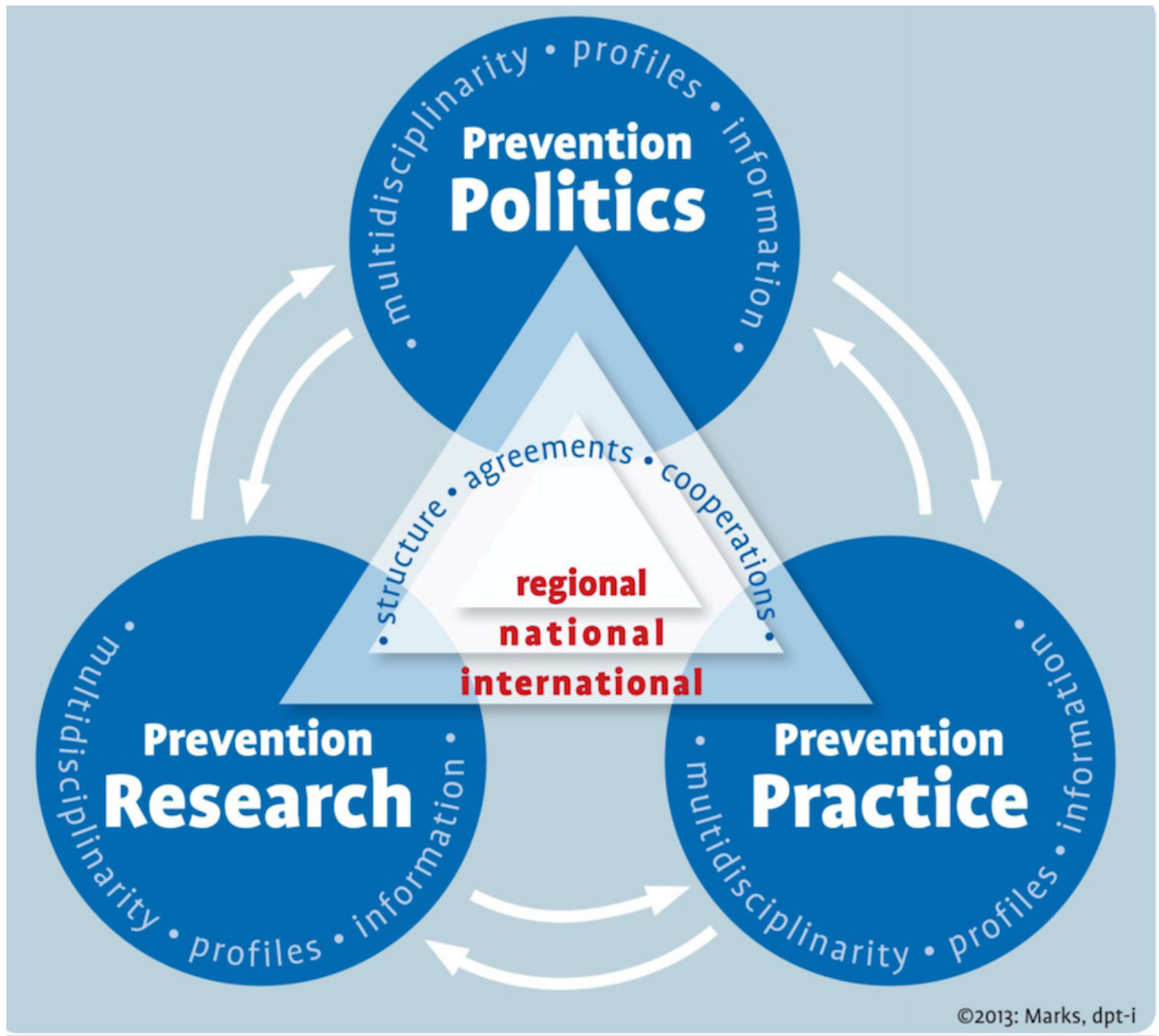


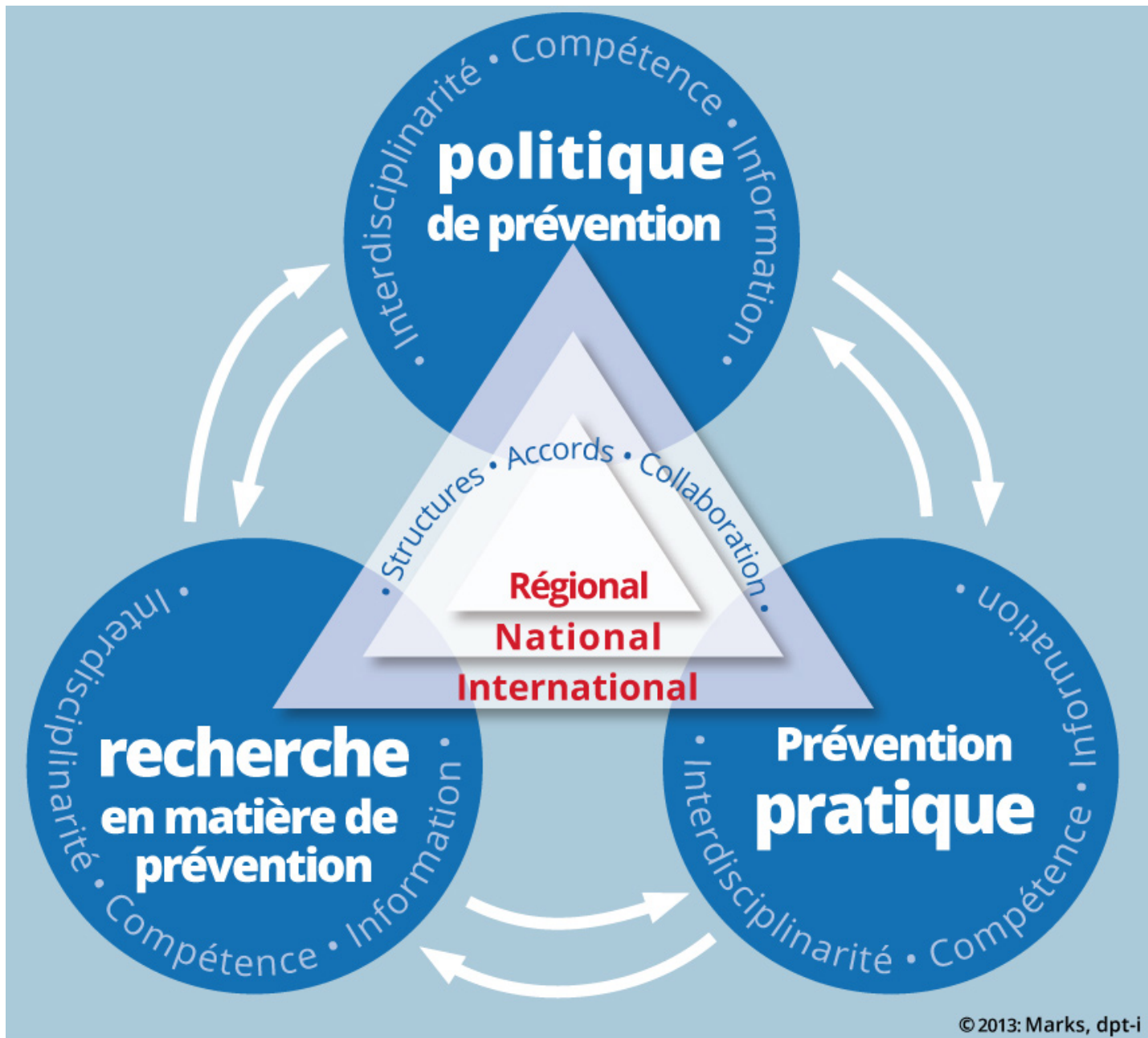


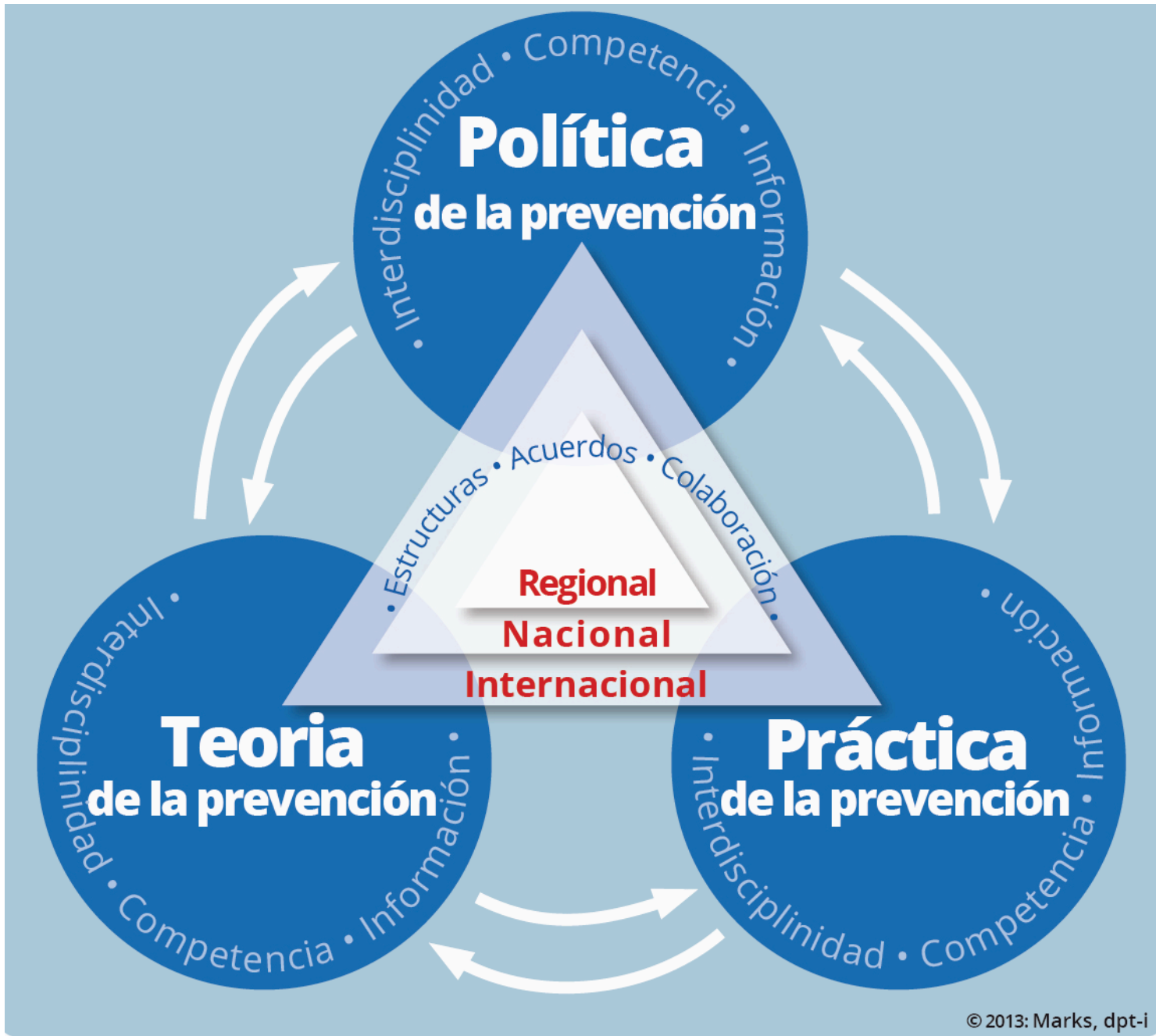

At each level (regional, national, international) at least an additional 10% of the sum of all expenditure on police and justice should always be made allocated for prevention purposes.
