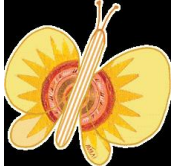

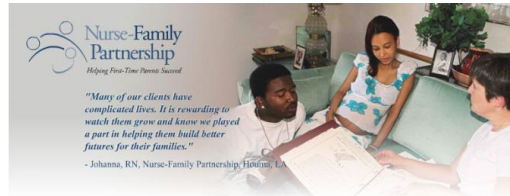

As an annually organised congress, the main objectives of the Congress are:

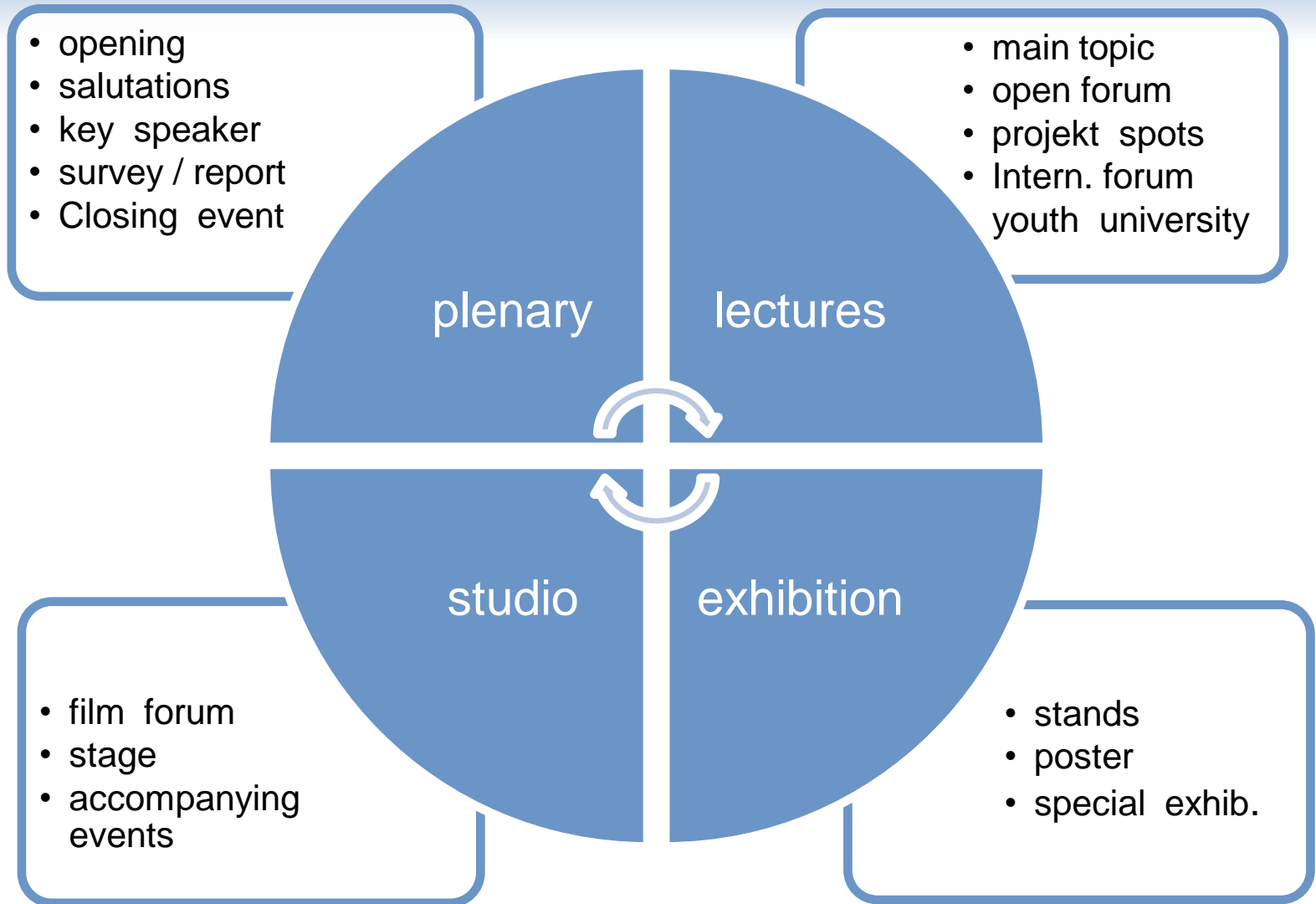
- ⊙ Presenting and exchanging current and basic questions of crime prevention and its effectiveness
